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




All of us have our loved places, all of us have laid claim to parts of the world, and all of us, whether we know it or not, are in some measure, the product of our sense of place.








THE FIRST EVIDENCE OF MAN'S PRESENCE IN THE NANAIMO AREA CAN BE FOUND IN THE PREHISTORIC PETROGLYPHS ON THE CITY'S SOUTHERN BORDER. THE COAST SALISH INDIANS WHICH INHABITED THE AREA BEFORE THE ARRIVAL OF EUROPEANS WERE GROUPED IN SEVERAL TRIBES. THE CONTINUAL RAIDS BY THE MORE NORTHERLY HAIDA PROMPTED THEM TO BAND TOGETHER INTO SNE-NY-MO (ONE STRONG TRIBE).




PICTURED ABOVE IS THE MOST




BASTION ST BRIDGE

THE HEAPING BOWLS OF FRIED RICE FOR ONLY 50¢. THE EXCITEMENT OF THE DRAGON AS IT PROCEEDED DOWN THE MAIN STREET ON CHINESE NEW YEAR. THE MACHINE GUN LIKE SOUND AS A COMPLETE STRING OF FIRECRACKERS WENT OFF. THE SHUFFLE OF AN ELDERLY CHINAMAN AS HE WENT DOWN THE WOODEN SIDEWALK HAND ON WRIST BEHIND HIS BACK. THE BOISTEROUS SATURDAY NIGHT CROWD HUNGRY FOR THE DELICIOUS CHINESE FOOD HAVING DANCED THE EVENING AWAY AT THE PYGMY DANCE HALL. YES AND THERE WERE BOOTLEGGLERS TOO BACK WHEN A MICKEY OF ADAMS RYE COULD BE HAD FOR FOUR DOLLARS.



THE OLD SHIP THE "CHARMER" (LATER REPLACED BY THE PRINCESS VICTORIA) WAS TIED TO THE DOCK AT ECHO BAY AND SERVED AS A FLOATING HOTEL. SHIPS FROM VANCOUVER BROUGHT AS MANY AS 1,500 PEOPLE AT A TIME TO HOLIDAY ON THE ISLAND.

IN 1955 THE CITY OF NANAIMO BOUGHT THE ISLAND AND TURNED IT OVER TO THE PROVINCE IN 1961 AS A PROVINCIAL PARK.

MANSON'S STORE WAS KNOWN BY ALL EARLY NANAIMOITES IN PARTICULAR SOUTHERNERS. THE GENEROUS CREDIT EXTENDED TO COAL MINERS AND INDIANS CARRIED MANY A FAMILY THROUGH HARD TIMES. THE IMAGE OF ERNIE AND BILL MANSON GREETING CUSTOMERS WITH GOOD MORNING OR KLA-HOW-YA IS FOREVER LINKED WITH MY VISION OF A PIONEER GENERAL STORE. THE HIGH BUTTON SHOES DISPLAYED IN BARKERVILLE ARE FROM MANSON'S ALSO MANY MORE OF THE PERIOD COSTUME PIECES. IT WAS GENERALLY BELIEVED IF YOU COULDN'T GET IT AT MANSON'S OR DODDSON'S HARDWARE YOU COULDN'T GET IT IN NANAIMO.
